Introduction:

The history of hotels and other places where alcohol was sold in New South Wales are closely tied to the laws created by successive Colonial and State governments to control the trade. Hotels operated, were rebuilt, and closed under the laws of the land. Three important periods in this process were 1882-3, 1905 and 1919-23.

The first licensing of public houses in NSW occurred in 1796, while laws in 1825, 1830, 1833, 1835, 1844, 1849, and 1862 controlled the opening hours and the number of bedrooms hotels must have available to the public for accommodation. Copies of the early publicans licences can be found in the Genealogical Kit issued by the State Archives of NSW. From 1865 to 1921 the names of holders of liquor licences issued by the Government were published in the NSW Government Gazette.

The first specific Licensing Act in New South Wales in 1825 called for a closing hour of 9 p.m. six days a week with all day Sunday closing. In 1849 the closing hour was extended to 10 p.m. and finally in 1862 hotels were allowed to open from 4 a.m. to midnight six days a week and from 1 to 3 p.m. on Sundays. The 1882 and 1883 Acts were a reaction to this liberalisation. They reduced the opening hours to 6 a.m. to 11 p.m. six days a week and reintroduced Sunday closing. In 1916 six o'clock closing was carried by referendum, extended indefinitely by Parliament in 1919, retained by referendum in 1947 and finally repealed, also by referendum in 1954.

That a hotel was more than a drinking shop and should provide accommodation was emphasised in 1830, 1833, 1835, 1844, and 1882-3. While the earlier laws stated that hotels should have at least two bedrooms and two sitting rooms for public use, the 1882-3 Acts increased this to four bedrooms, each not less than 1200 cubic feet in size.

From 1882-3 hotels were under siege from both the economy and legislation. The 1882-3 Liquor Acts introduced municipal Local Option allowing ratepayers to decide the fate of their neighbourhood hotels. They could vote to either increase the number of hotels in their municipality or to continue the existing number, but not to cut hotel numbers. Despite this hotel numbers did decline in the 1890s, largely as a result of the depressed economy.

The power to close hotels was not given to the public till 1905, when Local Option based on electorates rather than municipalities and using parliamentary franchise was introduced. Polls were held in 1905, 1910 and 1913. After the polls Reduction or Local Option Courts were set up to decide which hotels would close. Hotels could only be closed in areas that voted for Reduction and many of the worst hotels were in areas that wanted to keep their hotels. In 1919, therefore, the government set up a Licensing Reduction Board to decrease hotels numbers across the State.

The publication of the names of licence holders in the Government Gazettes reflects the changing laws. From 1865 to 1881 licences were renewed every year in June or July. New licences were given at any time in the year but were still renewed at the annual meeting, even if that was only a month later. From 1882 licences were issued at any time during the year and then renewed exactly twelve months later, rather than at an annual

meeting. The cut off date - 1921 - also reflects changes in legislation. The 1923 Liquor (Amendment) Act abolished local Licensing Benches and made the Licensing Reduction Board responsible for the control of licences throughout the state.

How the Index works:

Publicans' licences are listed alphabetically by the hotel's name. All other licences are listed in the Index by place. The following list provides a guide to hotels by place, as well as a reference to place names that may have changed over time.

There is a separate alphabetical listing for all persons holding licences, no matter the type of licence.

* Indicates that the hotel was closed by a Local Option Court.

Please note that the number of hotel names does not indicate the number of hotels in existence in a place at any one time. There are 126 hotel names to be found for Newcastle and Cooks Hill. Yet the number of hotels in that area ranged from 35 in 1871 to 62 in 1881 and 43 in 1921. Hotels changed their names frequently, often with the arrival of a new licensee or merely to appear modern.
